

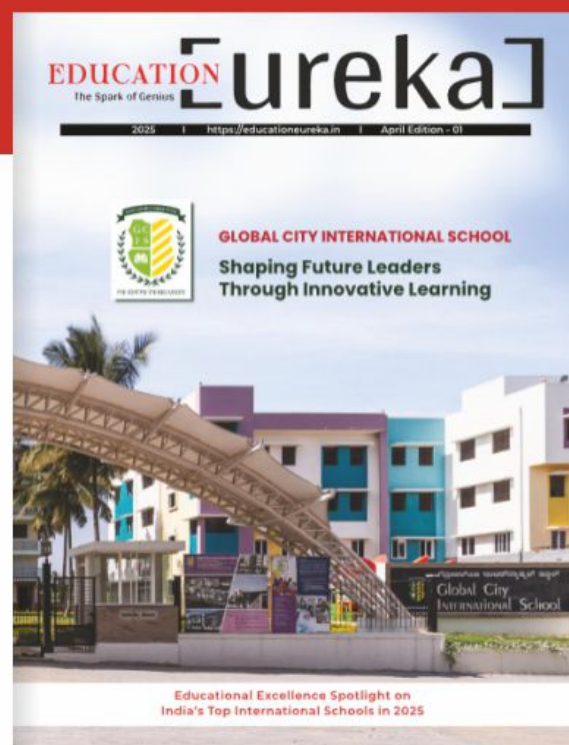

Nandha Gokulam Life School (NGLS) stands as the third educational institution supported by its chairman, Mr. Chinta Sasidhar, from its inception for the underprivileged. The core philosophy behind establishing a premier school for underprivileged children lies in the belief that education serves not only as a powerful equalizer but also as a transformative force to shape attitudes and build confidence. While many schools cater to the underprivileged, NGLS aims to provide a comprehensive ecosystem where children can thrive and compete on a global scale, free from limitations or inhibitions. By combining state-of-the-art wifi enabled, air-conditioned infrastructure, progressive classroom teaching

methodologies, and learning experiences designed by trained professionals, the school ensures that students emerge as confident individuals ready to face the world.

Enhancing the Accessibility of Quality Education

Nandha Gokulam Life School (NGLS) stands out as India's first premier residential school established by a business house exclusively dedicated to educating underprivileged boys from across the country. What sets NGLS apart is its self-reliant funding model, with the initiative entirely financed by its founding company Vishwa Samudra Holdings - [www.vishwasamudra.com], without reliance on external donations. The school's mission is to provide opportunities for learning and

growth equivalent to those available to children from economically privileged backgrounds.

Life with Plants and Animal on Campus

A unique feature of NGLS is its emphasis on connecting students with nature. By fostering an ecosystem where children nurture plants and animals, the school instills values of empathy, sensitivity, and environmental consciousness. Each student is encouraged to adopt and care for an indigenous cow or bull reared on campus, and they participate in organic farming as part of their weekly routine. This holistic engagement is complemented by future plans to introduce a senior living facility, allowing students to connect with and learn from the elderly.

Transcending Conventional Boundaries

Rooting students in Indian civilization and cultural heritage is a focused effort at NGLS. The library, which serves as the heart of the school, boasts an extensive collection of books and forms the foundation of the school's unique approach to education. Instead of traditional textbooks, students develop language skills and critical thinking through library resources and dedicated reading circles shared with

teachers. A project-based learning pro model challenges students and teachers alike to explore and innovate beyond conventional boundaries. An annual calendar ensures regular upskilling for teachers and staff, and the school is in the process of forming meaningful partnerships with national and international educational organizations. Beyond academics, NGLS emphasizes a well-rounded



development through a structured sports curriculum and recreational facilities like go-karting, ensuring students have diverse opportunities to enjoy and learn.

Overcoming Educational Obstacles

NGLS faces several challenges inherent to its unique mission and location. Being situated in a remote area, attracting the right talent for teaching and staff roles is often difficult. Additionally, the language barrier poses another significant hurdle. While most enrolled students primarily speak Telugu, teachers are recruited from across the country, bringing linguistic diversity but also requiring tailored efforts to bridge communication gaps. The academic foundation of incoming students, aged 9 to 12 in the first year, often falls far below grade-level expectations, particularly in



language and mathematics. Addressing these gaps requires extensive effort to bring them at par with the learning outcomes appropriate for their grade. Convincing underprivileged families, particularly from other states, to enroll their children in a residential school has also been challenging. Many parents harbor doubts about the intentions behind establishing a premier school for the underprivileged and fear sending their children far from home. To overcome these obstacles, NGLS organizes regular parent orientations and meetings conducted in the local language, fostering trust and understanding within the community. These initiatives aim to reassure families of the school's commitment to their child's growth and well-being while building a strong foundation for a brighter future.

Technological Integration for Safer and Collaborative Learning

At NGLS technology is seamlessly integrated both into the curriculum and the overall campus environment to enhance learning and ensure safety. On the safety front, the residential campus employs Swiss technology-based safety locks, providing a secure environment for all students. Project-based learning forms the core of the school's educational philosophy and relies heavily on technology for research and self-directed learning.

Fostering Well-Rounded Individuals

At NGLS, extracurricular activities are an integral part of the students' education, treated with the same importance as academic subjects. These activities—spanning sports, art education, theatre, dance, and more—serve as essential tools to help children build confidence, express themselves, and form meaningful relationships. The school has partnered with a

Mumbai-based organization to implement a structured sports curriculum, ensuring professional guidance and comprehensive development in sports. Additionally, the dance studio focuses on teaching classical dance forms, providing students with an opportunity to connect with cultural heritage while enhancing their creativity and discipline. These co-curricular programs are designed to holistically develop students, fostering well-rounded personalities and life skills.



Various digital tools are utilized to support students in subjects like mathematics and languages, helping them grasp concepts more effectively. As a Microsoft 365 School, NGLS ensures its facilitators receive regular training to stay updated with the latest technological advancements, enabling them to create dynamic and engaging learning experiences. Recognizing that many parents are not tech-savvy or financially equipped to engage with online platforms, the school prioritizes in-person meetings held at regular intervals.

These sessions aim to build a connection between the school and the parents while keeping them informed about their children's progress. Given the residential nature of the school and the limited educational background of most parents, the responsibility for advancing students' learning primarily rests with the school. However, through consistent communication and engagement, NGLS ensures that parents remain informed and involved in their child's educational journey to the best of their ability.
